Gateway Reviews



Gateway is a program whereby high value or high-risk Cabinet approved programs are subject to periodic reviews. These reviews examine implementation governance, process and confidence.

Sententia Consulting has undertaken over 80 of these reviews throughout the last 15 years of major programs on matters including technology implementation, policy implementation, major construction and organisational transformation. The total value of these reviews is in excess of \$50b.

The practical experience in government program implementation from these reviews provides broad ranging insights.

Project Operational Support



Sententia Consulting supported the COVID-19 Vaccine rollout and the achievement of the objectives of the program, through the provision of pragmatic, influential and responsive probity advice, assurance advice, and project and operational support.

Our team of trusted and experienced personnel worked closely with the departments delivering the program to manage probity risk, obtain independent assurance and operational support, and progress the delivery of the vaccine roll-out.

Property Acquisition Project and Change Management



Since mid-2021, Sententia Consulting has been engaged by a state government department to re-design all aspects of the way they acquire property.

This engagement involved all aspects of functional and process design, governance design and execution, performance and assurance management design, development of the suite of artefacts to support implementation, and all aspects of project management.

From the commencement of the engagement, we applied change management methods to support the transition as were subsequently engaged to embed and reinforce the changes with teams across the Department.

Portfolio, Program and Project Management Advice



Sententia Consulting worked with a small agency which was experiencing difficulties in the execution of its range of programs and projects.

We were appointed to provide timely advice on how to establish fit-for purpose structures for portfolio, program and project governance, oversight and management.

The agency accepted our advice and implemented structures and governance accordingly.

Portfolio, Program and Project Management Capability Maturity Assessment and Uplift



Sententia Consulting was commissioned by an agency to review their portfolio, program and project management current state capability using a P3M3 assessment.

Once the current state maturity was determined, we worked with the agency to determine their desired future state, taking into consideration the planned investment in projects to drive change, the capability needed to deliver the changes, the cost to uplift the Agency, and the timeframe available to increase their portfolio, program and project maturity.

Key areas needing improvement were identified and activities developed to deliver the capability uplift. An implementation roadmap was designed to capture the activities and deliver them in a sequential order taking dependencies and delivery timeframes into consideration. We developed and supported the capability uplift activities including an education program.

Project Management Establishment and Support



Over more than 3 years, Sententia Consulting provided support to a large government review which impacted all Australians. The Review required a complex governance arrangement that met political expectations and delivery requirements, and required a team within the Department of approximately 40 FTE including public service staff and external experts.

The Sententia Consulting team was requested initially to provide advice on program governance, and was subsequently asked to establish a program management office to design governance and management arrangements, and then operate that PMO and support the Department leadership in delivering the Review.

The Review resulted in a comprehensive set of recommendations and observations regarding: clarity of strategy, governance capability, performance management, governance and risk management. These recommendations provided an opportunity for the Review to improve accountability and alignment of business objectives.

Portfolio Management and Investment Planning Review



Sententia Consulting completed two strategic reviews for a large government business entity.

The first was a review of their portfolio, program and project management. This involved an in-flight assessment of the design, and implementation of changes in portfolio, program and project management to be more flexible and tailored to the client's needs.

The second review focused on enterprise investment planning and management, which looked at the design and oversight of their investment portfolio. These reviews had high visibility from the Executive and Board, resulting in material recommendations for **improvement** which have since been implemented.



Project Assurance



Sententia Consulting conducted a review of Phase 1 of a significant government project to provide the department with independent assurance and advice in preparation for future phases.

Following the completion of the review, Sententia Consulting embedded a team to work with the department to review and update the project governance structure and supporting suite of project management documents appropriate for a Tier 1 project.

Key to this document suite was the 'Concept of Operations' which provided an end-to-end pathway for the integration of existing capability and development of new capability.
